1. **Signed Consent Forms Due:** April 12, 2010. **Registration Forms Done On Line Due:** April 1, 2010.

We will be sending a course registration verification report home for you to review with your student and to sign and return to us at the school.

2. **Graduation requirement is 24 credits to achieve a Grade 12 diploma:** It is recommended at the grade 11 level that students take 5 classes per semester in order to meet and/or exceed all of the Ministry of Education requirements prior to graduation.

3. **6 Period Day:** 8:55-3:30 courses are scheduled into 6 period blocks with lunch period generally scheduled into periods 3, 4, or 5 when possible.

4. **Extended Math Courses:** are only available to students meeting extended math criteria as assessed by GHS Student Support Services Team

5. **Modified courses:** Modified courses and modified registration forms (11/21/31) are only available to students that have been assessed by GHS Student Support Services Team and met modified criteria. Students registering in modified course will meet with Student Support Services coordinator to register for their courses.

6. **Outdoor School 20 Program:** The outdoor school provides an opportunity for students to complete all of the academic requirements for a regular Grade 11 semester. **Course offerings currently include: English Language Arts 20, Physical Education 20, Wildlife Management 30, Native Studies 20 and Biology 20.** Students who participate in the course will also obtain CRCA canoeing certification and First Aid / CPR certification. **STUDENTS THAT MAKE THIS COURSE SELECTION ARE TO ALSO SIGN UP FOR REGULAR COURSE SELECTIONS TO ALLOW THEM TO BE REGULARLY SCHEDULED IN THE EVENT THIS COURSE IS NOT APPROVED OR THERE IS NOT ENOUGH STUDENT INTEREST.**
